These are those musicians who lead their sections and perform the instrumental solos throughout the season. Your name will be published in the orchestra roster as the supporter of the principal of the section of your choice all season.

- **Music Director Sponsorship (season): \$15,000**
 - Logo projected on stage before weekend concert series
 - Full page color ad in all five concert programs
 - Appreciation announcement for sponsorship from the stage at all concerts
 - Your name published in the orchestra roster as the supporter of the Music Director
 - Priority placement on our website sponsorship page
 - Ten (10) season tickets
 - Logo on all marketing materials/social media
- **Season Sponsor (season): \$25,000**
 - Logo projected on stage before every concert
 - Full page color ad in all five+ concert programs
 - Appreciation announcement for sponsorship from the stage at each performance
 - Logo on all marketing materials/social media
 - Display corporate banner in lobby for each concert, sponsor to provide print ready art
 - Priority placement on our website sponsorship page
 - Ten (10) season tickets, category exclusivity, right of refusal prior to beginning of each season
